Mustardseed Cultural and Environmental Services, LLC (MCE) conducted a Historic Wallpaper Survey of the structures at the Harry S Truman National Historic Site. MCE determined the ages and manufacturers of the wall and ceiling papers in interior structures of Truman Home and Farm Home and provided photographic and written documentation detailed enough to allow the information to be forwarded to wallpaper reproduction companies for reproduction papers to match the historical appearance for future wallpaper replacement. MCE provided all equipment, supplies, materials and expertise to examine, identify and document all existing wallpaper in spaces listed on the Inventory of Wallpapered Spaces in the Truman Home, Independence, Missouri and the Inventory of Wallpapered Spaces in the Truman Farm Home located in Grandview, Missouri and to research the extant wallpapers. MCE also determined the age and manufacturers of the wall and ceiling papers in both structures. The documentation provided information on the existing paper condition and compromises.
