



NAHB Green Building Verification and Certification

MCE will provide verification and certification services in compliance with the ANSI Green Building Standard. The services include:

- Complete preliminary plan review. Develop a Designer's Report with the project's owner for the building that is going to be verified
- Develop a verification report spreadsheet - specific scoring path noted in the designer's report and transfer information and points claimed from designer's report (decided on by the owner and verifier); print copy to use as the guide for the inspections.
- Assist the owner with the NAHB registration process.
- Schedule rough inspection with builder and owner. Notify the NAHB research center.
- Confirm with the builder and owner at the beginning of rough inspection - the points claimed and level of certification targeted.
- Complete rough inspection prior to the building walls being covered following the instructions listed in the Verifier's Resource Guide. Document and store relevant building information such as submittals, pictures, 3rd party reports, etc that can be verified at the time of the open wall inspection.
- E-mail rough verification report (on or before day following inspection) to NAHB Research Center; that will meet all of the NAHB report requirements.
- Schedule duct blaster/blower door test with appropriate 3rd party subcontractor if required. Obtain compliance reports from that subcontractor for verification.
- Schedule final inspection with the owner and builder. Notify the NAHB research center.
- Complete final inspection following the instructions listed in the Verifier's Resource Guide. Document and store the remaining relevant building information that needs to be verified prior to building certification.
- E-mail final verification report (same day as inspection) to NAHB Research Center; the report will include all required information.
